

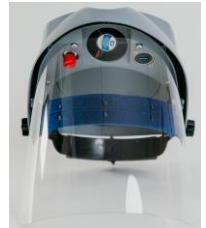


INSTRUCTION BOOKLET

Congratulations! You have just taken a significant step towards improving the air you breathe. The Air Shield™ is the first-of-its-kind device designed to give you pristine air quality no matter where you are.

Wearing the Air Shield™

1. Before putting on the Air Shield™, position the Air Shield™ so you can see and reach the red power button with your finger.
2. Press the red button to turn on the fan.
3. Slide the Air Shield™ helmet onto your head so that it sits comfortably with the black headband control knob located at the back of your head.
4. Gently turn the black knob until it fits snugly. Moving your head up and down and to the left and right is helpful to ensure a tight fit. Adjust accordingly.



***NOTE:** The Air Shield™ may require slight adjustment should you have an abundance of hair. You may experience some slippage of the device even when tightened.*

5. When ready to remove the Air Shield™, lift the device off your head. If tight, turn the black knob counterclockwise. Press the red button again to turn off the device.

***NOTE:** The protective face shield should parallel your face for optimum air curtain flow. If you are in a poor air environment, we do not recommend lifting the face shield to eat or drink, as doing so will affect the Air Shield™ performance.*

Charging the Air Shield™

1. Plug the USB recharge cable into the USB port on the underside of the device. Then, plug the other end of the line into a USB AC adapter or USB computer port.

***NOTE:** You will want to recharge the Air Shield™ 15 minutes for every 1 hour of use. It will fully recharge within 90 minutes.*

Optimizing the Air Shield™ filter system

1. As you begin wearing the Air Shield™, you will feel the gentle flow of clean air blowing over your eyes, nose, and chin. This flow should remain steady under normal conditions and use.
2. This model is NOT intended for use when participating in sports with a high level of physical activity.
3. Always protect the top filter-opening from rain or snow by using an umbrella. Do not block this opening, as it will impede airflow through the filters.
4. Under regular use, you should replace the air filter system every 6 – 12 months. Variations in air quality from moderate to unhealthy levels (including wildfire smoke and dust storms) and high winds will reduce the effectiveness of the air filter system.

Note: To ensure a clean air experience, be sure your head and face are free of odors from hairspray, makeup, smoke, fumigants, aerosols, etc.

Cleaning the face shield

1. Use a microfiber cloth to clean the face shield. Avoid using any harsh chemicals.
2. To clean and remove fingerprints, makeup, or other removable marks or blemishes, and for general cleaning and disinfecting, perform the following:
 - Add 50/50 water and rubbing alcohol (70% Isopropyl Alcohol) into a small spray bottle.
 - Spray the solution onto a microfiber cloth and wipe the surface area.
 - When cleaning the inner or outer surface, using a second cloth on the opposite surface is helpful to provide pressure against the surface you are cleaning.
 - Wipe dry with a clean, dry microfiber cloth.
3. Add vinegar to the water to remove water stains on the face shield. Avoid using any harsh chemicals.
4. Should your face shield accumulate scratches, cracks, or stains, you can order a face shield replacement by contacting safeairhealth.org/store.

Storing the Air Shield™

1. When you are not wearing the device, we recommend placing it in the cloth storage box.
2. Follow cleaning and charging procedures before storing it so it is ready for use when needed.

Read and follow all instructions before using the Air Shield.

- Keep this device out of reach of small children. In the event of emergency use, only wear it under adult supervision.
- Do not place objects in or on top of the filter cover and fan opening while in use, as blockage will impede airflow.
